Dispose of drugs in a way that creates reusable energy rather than risking contamination.



- ✗ Medical waste
- ✗ Medical equipment
- ✗ Mercury thermometers
- ✗ Inhalers
- ✗ Sharps (e.g., needles, syringes, scalpels, lancets)
